The Leadership 1000 Scholarship is \$2,500 to \$5,000 per year, for up to four years, for students who need assistance attending an eligible four-year college or university in Washington state. Please take a moment to review the eligibility criteria on our [website](#).

The Governors' Scholarship for Foster Youth provides \$2,000 to \$4,000 per year, for up to five years, for youth who have or will emancipate from foster care in Washington state to attend college. Please take a moment to review the eligibility criteria on our [website](#).

The Celebration of Faith Scholarship

This scholarship is presently expected to award up to \$1,500 annually. Up to three scholarships will be awarded each year.
