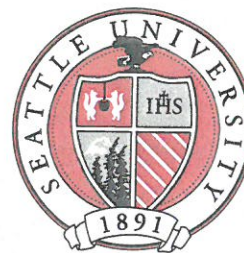

Please share this information with your students regarding Seattle University's prestigious Sullivan Leadership Award. Each year, nine incoming first-year students are selected to receive the Sullivan Leadership Award on the basis of their demonstrated academic excellence, service and leadership. Sullivan Scholars receive **full tuition, room, and meals for each of four years** of undergraduate study at Seattle University. While attending Seattle University, award recipients participate in a 4-year leadership development program. Sullivan Scholars come from a variety of ethnic backgrounds, small towns and large cities, public and independent schools, and different religious traditions. Enclosed you will find our Sullivan Leadership Award poster to display in your College Counseling Center. Please encourage students meeting the following criteria to apply:

- Academic Excellence:** Pursuit of rigorous college preparatory coursework and typically have a GPA of 3.7 or higher.
- Leadership:** Participation and demonstrated leadership in school activities, public service, and community involvement.
- Service:** Commitment to justice and the good of others through service.
- Communication:** Effective oral and written communication skills.
- Residence:** Domestic students attending high school and residing in the United States.

The Sullivan Leadership Award Application, along with a *complete* Early Action admissions application, must be submitted online on or before **November 15, 2017**. Candidates who are admitted Early Action and qualified for the Sullivan Leadership Award are *required* to attend the Sullivan Leaders' Day competition on **Saturday, January 20, 2018**, on the Seattle University campus. We will have a limited amount of travel grant funds available to help with transportation costs for qualified applicants. Eligibility requirements for the travel grant can be found at www.seattleu.edu/sullivan/process. Forty-five finalists will be invited back for the final competition on **Friday, March 9, 2018**. Award recipients will be notified by early April.
