

High School Graduation Requirements

1. One (1) credit equals one year of study in a class period. Therefore, a semester grade equals one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) credit. Students must earn a minimum of 29.5 credits to graduate.
2. No more than $\frac{1}{2}$ credit per semester or one credit per year may be applied toward graduation requirements in these subjects. Exceptions will be allowed only in cases where a student has failed a previous course.

Community service: 70 hours required over four years

Freshman (9th grade) year – 10 hours

Junior (11th grade) year – 20 hours

Sophomore (10th grade) year – 15 hours

Senior (12th grade) year – 25 hours

Excess community service hours cannot be carried over from year to year.

NOTE: The district has the discretion to award credit when clearly defined competencies have been mastered. Therefore, online and independent study courses may be substituted for graduation requirements at the discretion of the principal/superintendent.

* The Washington State History credit is received while in 7th grade.

** The second year of health and fitness may be waived if two sports seasons are completed in one academic year.
